CODE OF CONDUCT, REGULATIONS & POLICY

SKCC is affiliated with the UCI, Cycling Australia and Cycling Victoria. Licenced riders are bound by their Codes of Conduct, Regulations and Policy.

Licensed riders are also bound by the Victorian Code of Conduct for Community Sport.

Riders must follow SKCC Race Rules (see website) and may be subject to penalties for committing any of the following offences:

- R1** Behaving in a manner inconsistent with the Victorian Code of Conduct for Community Sport, Cycling Australia and Cycling Victoria Code of Conduct;
- R2** Parking vehicles in unsafe manner or in area not designated for parking;
- R3** Failure to use designated toilet facilities. Any breach of this rule will be treated as a Serious Offence;
- R4** Failure to present a current Cycling Australia or UCI competitive license, or purchase a day license or 3-race license, or club receipt or email confirmation of on-line renewals at the registration desk every race.
- R5** Presentation of a bicycle not in conformity with the regulations or in an unsafe condition.
- R6** Wearing inappropriate, unsafe or offensive race attire.
- R7** Leaving rubbish at venues or failure to place rubbish in bins;
- R8** Failure to comply with directions given by officials, Commissaires and support personnel assisting or conducting events;
- R9** Failure to follow directions from course marshals and race officials without question or delay;
- R10** Warming up or cooling down on the racing circuit when another race is underway;
- R11** Riding in an dangerous, aggressive, erratic or unpredictable manner which does or could result in other competitors having to take evasive action or crash;
- R12** Failure to maintain a straight course where possible;
- R13** Failure to keep to the left side of the circuit unless overtaking a slower bunch.
- R14** Deviating from the line when the back wheel is not clear of the front wheel of riders following behind or to either side – i.e. you must not cut another rider off when overtaking or attacking.
- R15** Attempting to improve position in corners, in particular by diving up the inside of the bunch.
- R16** Failing to follow (hold) the line set by the bunch or rider ahead through corners whenever it is safe to do so.
- R17** Striking the road surface with a pedal while cornering.
- R18** Leaving the racing circuit proper and improving position within the bunch.
- R19** Failure to keep both hands on the handlebars, unless a rider is taking a drink.
- R20** Failing to report incidents or near misses to the Commissaire or entry table officials to have the details of their accident recorded, regardless of whether they require first aid treatment.
- R21** Gaining assistance from riders from any other grade on the circuit at the same time.
- R22** When lapped, failing to withdraw from the circuit at '3 to go' or when directed by officials.
- R23** Riding or about to ride without a helmet.
- R24** Failing to allow faster bunches to overtake without taking pace from or obstructing them;
- R25** In a sprint deviating from selected line and endangering other riders;
- R26** Failing to pass a slower bunch on the right;
- R27** Failure to return racing numbers promptly after completing racing;
- R28** In time trails slip steaming or failing to maintain regulation distances and gaps;
- R29** Failure to exit the racing circuit immediately after completing a race to avoid interfering with other bunches;
- R30** Failure to observe the centre line rule on open road circuits;
- R31** Pulling, pushing or obstructing another rider;
- R32** Insults, threats, obscene, unseemly behaviour, language or gestures;
- R33** Acts of violence; and
- R34** Using a mobile phone, music device of any kind or radio during a race
